Week 1: Leadership Foundations (September 18)

Before you can effectively lead others, you must begin by leading yourself. In week 1 you will:

- Explore the differences between 'managing' and 'leading'
- Use the [LQ] Leadership Intelligence framework to establish what a successful leader looks like in the Public Service
- Establish your baseline strengths and areas for improvement

Week 2: Authentic and Impactful Communication (October 2)

Mastering the art of communication is the key to effective leadership, building a thriving team, and departmental success. You will:

- Analyze the fundamentals of communication, how it works, and the impact it has on your relationships and interactions
- Improve 2-way communication through active listening, powerful questioning, and knowing your audience

Week 3: Leading and Developing Your Team (October 16)

Discover your Managerial Style with the [LQ] Management Style Assessment powered by Everything DiSC. Knowing your style is critical in effectively leading diverse teams and building trusted relationships. You will;

- Explore your Managerial Style using the results of your assessment
- Understand the impact of your style on others
- Recognize the working style of others



Week 4: Engaging for Higher Performance (October 30)

As a people leader you are accountable for achieving results with, and through, the success of your team. You will:

- Explore a Cycle of Excellence to engage employees, continuously improve, and drive results
- Use the [LQ] Leadership Intelligence framework to examine and address employee performance concerns
- Script and prepare effective feedback statements to communicate constructive feedback

Week 5: Navigating Your Public Service Career (November 13)

It's important to be equipped with the soft skills necessary to be an effective leader, but it is equally as critical to understand how to logistically become a leader in the Public Service. You will:

- Identify your unique Career Identity and what you want from your career
- Explore strategies to navigate and advance in your career
- Develop a plan to take what you've learned and apply it to transform your career

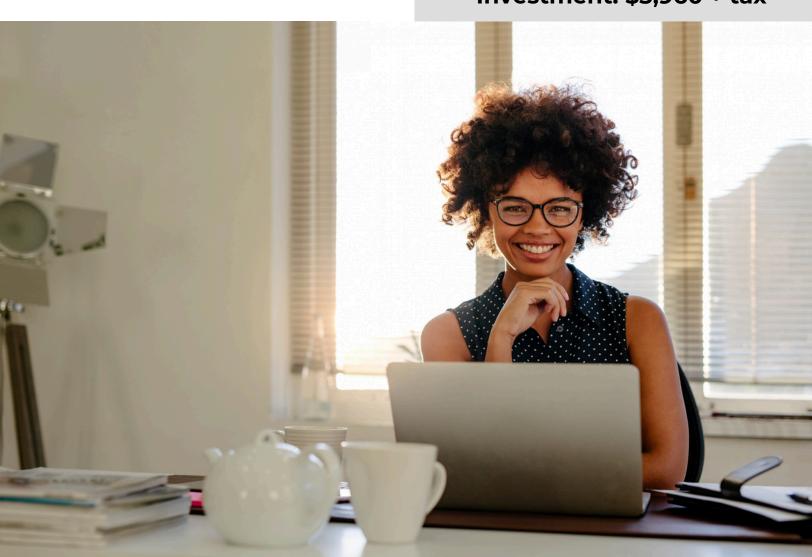
